








Join the new BAND!

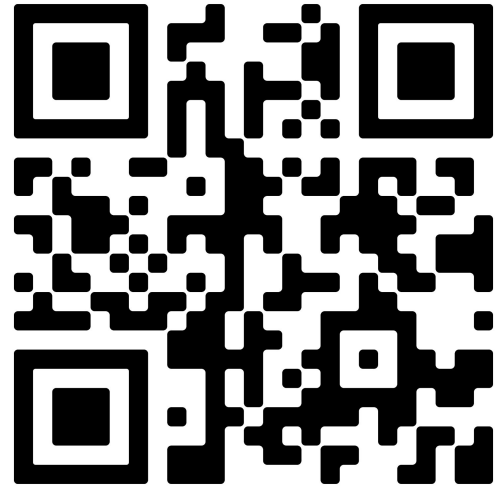

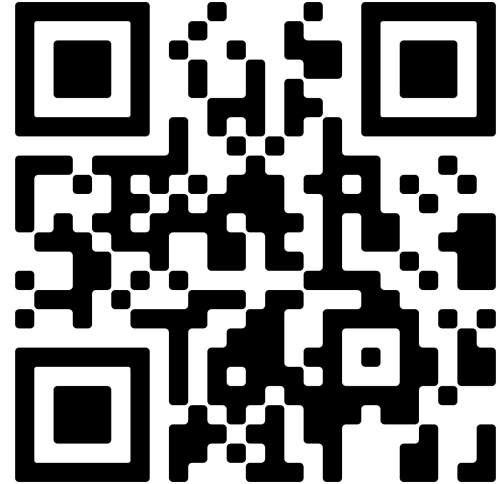


